The evening began with the Annual Assembly of the Parish. The Parish Council Chairman's report gave details of the past year's significant events. This was followed by brief resumes from local village groups. Thank you to all who contributed to the meeting.

Following refreshments, the Parish Council sat down to hold their monthly meeting. A planning application to replace a storm-damaged shed with another shed (which will be used to house calves & dry cows) at Manor Farm, High Street was discussed. The councilors were happy to support the application, but also wanted to comment that the preference was for a roof than blended in with the background (eg brown or grey).

There is a small area of fencing, that has fallen-over on the bridge over the brook at the bottom of North Lane (near the community field). It was decided that this maybe a highways issue and the clerk agreed to report to Somerset Council.

The Parish Council have decided to donate £750 to the West Coker and Hardington Cricket Club, which is the remainder needed to be found, to help purchase the new exceptional cricket nets.

Stewart Ogden has agreed to take on the new 'ranger' contract within the village. This involves tasks such as strimming, keep areas tidy and generally doing jobs to help keep the village looking nice!
